



Playgroup Syllabus

Core Subject Areas

A playgroup syllabus focused on holistic development through play, covering-

1. **Language & literacy:** Basic vocabulary (fruits, animals), storytelling, rhymes (e.g., “Teddy Bear”), picture reading, listening to instructions, recognizing names, basic letter sounds, and simple pre-writing strokes (lines, curves).
2. **Pre-Numeracy & Math:** Recognizing colors, shapes (circle, square, triangle), sorting, matching, big vs. Small, patterns, and counting 1-10 using visuals and rhymes.
3. **Motor Skill Development:**
 - **Fine Motor:** Clay molding, threading beads, scribbling, coloring, cutting with safety scissors.
 - **Gross Motor:** Running, jumping, balancing, dancing.
4. **General Awareness (Environmental science):** Self, family, animals, seasons, transport, healthy habits, body parts, and basic manners.

Activities & Themes

1. **Creative Arts:** Drawing, painting, music, movement, puppet shows, and crafts.
2. **Themed Learning:** Monthly themes like cleanliness, sharing, fruits, or vehicles, integrating songs, stories, and activities.
3. **Social & Emotional Growth:** Learning to express needs, share toys, follow simple rules, build confidence, and work in groups.
4. **Storytelling & Rhymes:** Reinforce concepts and language development.

Example Activities

1. **English:** Learning “A” to “Z”, matching letters to pictures, simple conversations (What’s your name?).
2. **Math:** Counting objects, identifying shapes like triangles and squares, and matching numbers.
3. **General Knowledge:** identifying colors, fruits, animals, body parts, and days of the week.
